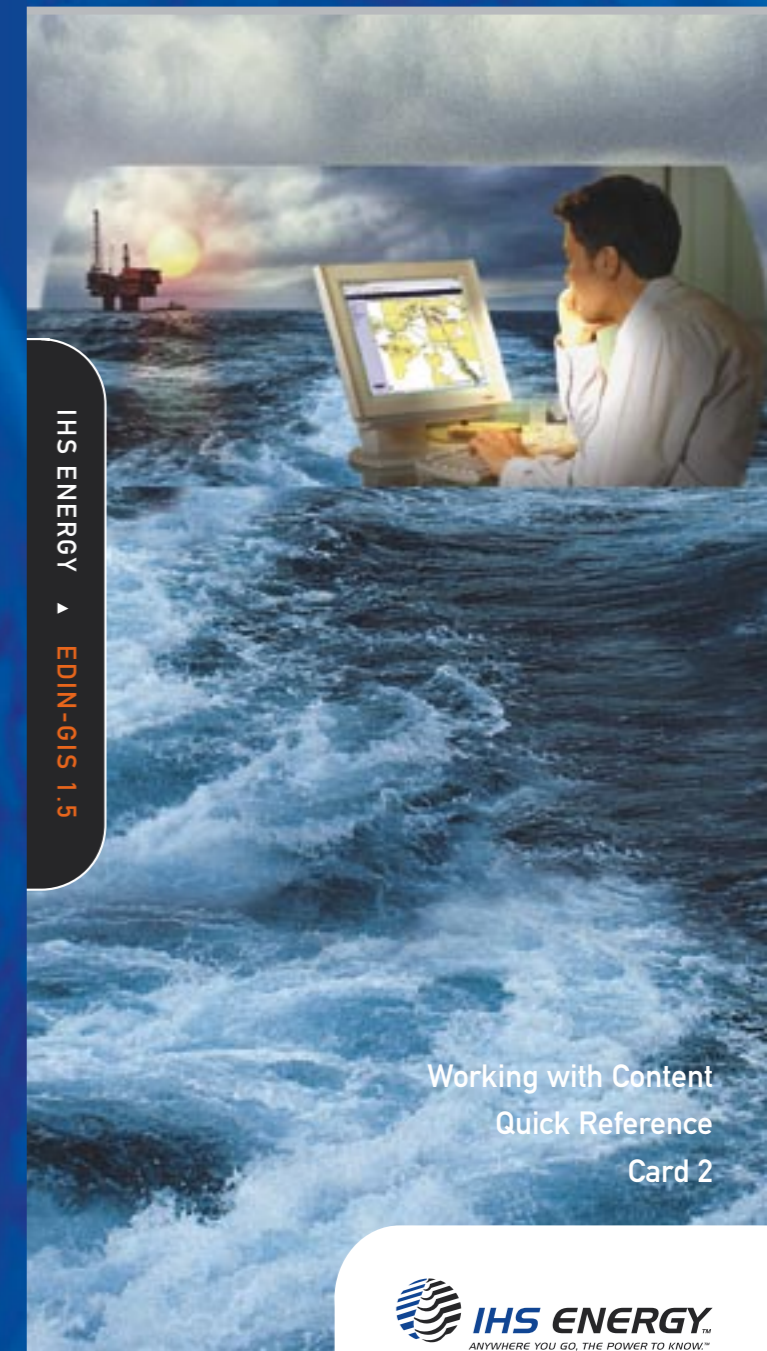

Quick Reference Card 2 – Contents

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1 How do I access GEPS suite information?


- a Editorial content is available from the 'Editorial Products' layer. Make ONE of the layers visible and active. Click on  then on a country to see a browse listing of content for that country. Select the hyperlink to see an article or a map.
- b Zoom in to approximately the area you are interested in and press the  icon. Then follow the easy instructions on screen to get a selection of relevant stories.
- c Make an entity selection with the Select by rectangle tool, click on the  icon. Follow the instructions again to view the stories of interest.

2 How do I access PEPS rating information and editorial reports?

- a Select the world view or a region of interest. Go to 'Map Layers' and open 'Fiscal/Political' and select the rating criteria of your choice and press the 'Refresh Map' button.
- b Select the 'PEPS Editorial Report' layer and make this active. Press the  icon and select any country of interest. This will produce a list of available reports for that country.

3 How do I access graphs?


To access Graphs, first make Wells, Fields, Basins or Contracts the active layer. Use the Select by Rectangle tool  to select either a single or group of entities.

You can view graphs in two ways: Select the Graph Tool , the graph will open in a new window. You can now select the other graphs available for this layer. Alternatively, use the Quick Browse Listing tool to show basic attributes for all selected entities. You can use the hyperlink to 'Go to Graphs'.

4 How do I change the map properties?

- a To change the Coordinate Reference System, zoom into your area of interest and select the 'Coordinate System' text at the bottom of the screen. This will display a list of the relevant UTM information for your current view. Choose and click 'Apply'.
- b To change the latitude and longitude settings, select the 'Lat/Long' text at the bottom of the screen. Enter the required lat/long information and press 'Apply'.



5 How can I print the map?

Press the  icon and select the options required. The PDF format will print to an Adobe file. The PNG format will create an image file suitable for importing into MS Office applications.

6 How do I view the date of the database and view my entitlements?

Select the 'about' link at the top right of the screen to view the date of the last database update. Click on the 'my entitlements' link to view your subscription information.

7 How do I create a report?

To create a report, make the desired layer active. Select entities with the Select by Rectangle tool . Select the Reporter tool . You will then be presented with a choice of standard report links.

8 How do I use the project manager?

To save a project click on 'PROJECTS', then 'NEW'. Enter the name, a description and choose whether or not to share this project with others in your company.

Then click on 'SAVE'. The project will save – any active preferences; any active projection; labelling parameters and visible layers. You can choose to change the visible layers by checking boxes next to the layer name.
