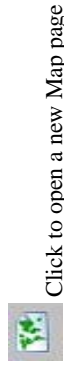
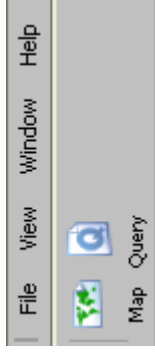
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# IHS Enerdeq Tool Button Quick Reference Card

## Homepage Tool Buttons (upper left corner of page)



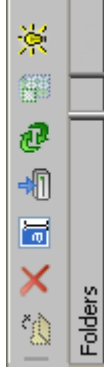
Click to open a new Map page



Click to open a new Query Editor page

## Homepage Tool Buttons (above the Folders Column)

(Will become active after a saved file is highlighted)



Will open a highlighted-saved Map or Query file



Will delete a highlighted saved file



Use to rename a saved file



Lets you download a saved export, graph or report file



Use to refresh the currently displayed page



Lets you open a saved Excel file



Retrieves an AOI Setup page

Click to open a new Query Editor page



Lets you select and retrieve a Saved Query



Click to save a currently displayed query



Click to generate a Browse list for query results



Click to display an Export selection page



Click to display a Graph selection page



Click to display a Report selection page

Click to open a New Map page

Click to Save the currently displayed Map

Provides a list of Zoom Level options to change the entire map image

Use to Zoom-In to a specific delineated area
  - 


Click to Zoom-In to entities selected on the map
  - 


Use to Reposition an area (up, down, left or right)
  - 


Use to Drag an area to a new position on the map
  - 


Returns the map to a previous display
  - 


Zooms the map view out to a Full View of the U.S.
  - 


The options in this tool will let you delineate an area on the map for analysis

Lets you retrieve a Quick Report for an inspectible layer on the map
  - 


Use to de-select selected entities on the map
  - 


Will let you select and export Spatial Layers from the map
  - 


Displays a Browse list for selected items on the map
  - 


Used to generate Export files for selected items on the map

Used to generate Graphs for selected items on the map
  - 


Used to generate Reports for selected items on the map
